The Bridgepoint Campus

Our “campus of wellness” is designed to inspire health and innovation, support healing, and act as a welcoming, accessible focal point for patients, staff and the community.

The Hospital

The 10-storey, 600,000 square foot state-of-the-art facility has 404 patient beds in rooms designed to accommodate the latest equipment, provide natural light, and is organized to facilitate the best patient care.

The Administration Building

The 84,000-square-foot structure is now renamed the Bridgepoint Administration Building and provides office space for hospital administrators, educators and clinical leaders.

The Grounds

Our campus, once complete, will be filled with garden spaces where patients and community members can enjoy the therapeutic benefits of the outdoors. Visitors can circulate through Bridgepoint’s gardens and landscaped walkways, enter the hospital’s historic administration building and connect to Riverdale Park from several entry points.

The last major milestone in the transformation of the Bridgepoint Active Healthcare campus is underway.


What's Happening?

The work to deconstruct the historic half-round hospital is now complete. We appreciate your support during the final period of demolition.

The easier work has now begun to take down the former Toronto Jail (red brick building adjacent to Broadview Avenue).

Over the coming weeks, you will see the building coming down in small pieces and debris being taken away. This work is expected to be completed by June. Periodically you will see construction vehicles on Broadview and Jack Layton, however they will not enter the community nor queue on Broadview.

PCL is monitoring vibrations daily to ensure compliance with city by-laws. Measures will be taken to control dust during demolition, however freezing temperatures combined with dry conditions will limit these measures occasionally. Once the warm weather begins, PCL will once again be able to consistently apply water and other measures to control the dust.



A New Landscape

This summer, you will begin to see the landscape of the Bridgepoint campus come to life.

The new central plaza will be constructed that includes Bridgepoint Drive, landscaping including flowers, plants and seating areas and the main entrance to the hospital will be completed.

This will also enable a seamless connection through the campus to the Riverdale Park.
